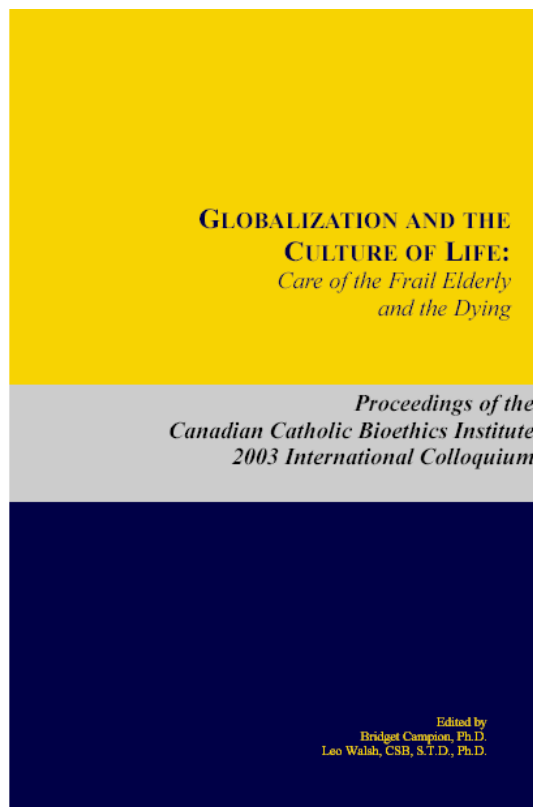

In July 2003, over fifty representatives of Catholic bioethics institutes from around the world gathered in Toronto to participate in an International Colloquium, "Globalization and the Culture of Life: Care of the Frail Elderly and the Dying." The Colloquium had four goals: to give directors and representatives of Catholic bioethics institutes the opportunity to share perspectives; to produce a statement from the discussions that would articulate a Catholic understanding of ethical care of the elderly and the dying; to identify questions for further research and to consider plans for ongoing mutual support and collaboration among Catholic bioethics institutes.

The Proceedings published in this 154-page volume (ISBN 0-9731322-4-8) are arranged chronologically in order to give a sense of the flow of the discussion. The Consensus Statement and signatories are also included.
